Basic Dojang Rules

- 1. Students should address all Black Belts as sir/ma'am or by their correct title.
- 2. Students should bow when entering or leaving the dojang (school).
- 3. Students should greet Head Instructors upon entering the dojang and say goodbye on their way out.
- 4. Students are expected to show deference to higher-ranking students and patience and assistance to lower-ranking students.
- 5. Students are not to use foul language or loud, disturbing behavior in the dojang.
- 6. Students should come to class with a clean uniform and be well groomed. All students should wear a black t-shirt under their uniform. Students are not permitted to wear jewelry in class. Absolutely no shoes are to be worn on the training mat.
- 7. Students should not smoke, drink, or chew gum in the dojang. Students should not come to class with alcohol on their breath.
- 8. Any student found gossiping about other students or instructors will be asked to leave the dojang.
- 9. Students are not allowed to wear their belt outside of the dojang. Students are not allowed to teach Kuk Sool outside of the dojang.
- 10. Students must use good judgement and manners when speaking to other Kuk Sool students regardless of the situation. Remember you are representing Kuk Sool Won of Greenville and we are one big family so we must be treated with respect.
